Paper Registration Form for the Vermont Emergency Response Volunteers (VERV)

The VERV site is operated by the Vermont Department of Health and allows you to register as a volunteer with a VERV response Unit that you are willing to provide services to during a disaster or emergency situation. This registration form will collect basic information about you and your professional skills such as your license number, expiration date, certifications, and contact information. Volunteers can be a health care professional or a non-health care volunteer.

All information you provide is held under the highest degree of care and standards of security, confidentiality, and privacy. Only you and authorized system administrators will view the information you enter. You may review the system's Terms of Service and Privacy Policy provided in Appendix I and II.

During a State or national disaster, the VERV system may receive requests for potential volunteers. If a decision is made to request your services as a volunteer, you will be contacted at that time by your unit administrator through this automated system and asked about your availability. You can choose, at any time, to decline any request for activation.

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APPENDIX I: TERMS of SERVICE REGISTRATION

By registering on the Vermont Emergency Response Volunteers Site (“Site”) for health professional and non-medical volunteers, I agree to be considered for service as a volunteer during a duly declared emergency, disaster, training event or other volunteer activity as requested. As part of the registration process, I agree to voluntarily provide personal information that will be collected, used and maintained by administrators implementing the Vermont Emergency Response Volunteers (“VERV”) Registry System.

Volunteer Selection Process

I understand that the process of being selected for service as a volunteer for a specific emergency/disaster is a process in which the information I enter at this Site will be evaluated to match mission requirements. I understand that, if selected, I will be contacted by VERV Site administrators and/or state or local emergency/disaster managers, and I will then be given the choice of whether or not I wish to volunteer my services for that specific emergency/disaster. I understand that if I volunteer for service for a specific emergency/disaster, my personal information will be forwarded to the requesting agency in the emergency/disaster operational area. I understand and agree that registering at this Site in no way obligates me to participate or deploy for a specific emergency/disaster, and that I may decline to participate or deploy at any time or for whatever reason.

Consent to Use and Disclosure of Personal Information

I understand that the information I provide will be used by VERV administrators to determine the status of my credential(s), if applicable, my healthcare license is current, valid, and free of any restrictions. By registering and agreeing to these Terms of Service, I agree to have the status of my credential(s) verified by federal or Vermont licensing/credentialing authorities. I also understand that the information I provide will be used by VERV administrators to assign me an emergency credentialing level in accord with applicable emergency credentialing standards. I understand that the assignment of an emergency credentialing level neither designates clinical privileges nor authorizes me to provide health services without proper authorization and supervision. I further understand that, during an emergency or disaster, the information I provide will be used by authorized VERV Site administrators and state or local emergency/disaster managers to assign me to activities for which I am adequately credentialed, and by on-site emergency/disaster operational area officials to identify me once I am deployed to the emergency/disaster locale. I hereby voluntarily consent to the collection, use, and maintenance of my personal information as described herein.

Statement of Physical and Mental Competence and Assumption of Risk

I acknowledge that by registering at this Site I am representing that I am of sound physical and mental capacity, and capable of performing in an emergency/disaster setting. I acknowledge that emergency/disaster settings can pose significant psychological and physical hardships and risks to those volunteering their services, and that emergency/disaster settings often lack the normal amenities of daily life and accommodations for persons with disabilities. In agreeing to volunteer my services, I agree to accept such conditions and risks voluntarily.

Consent to Volunteer Service and Liability and Workers’ Compensation Protections

By registering at this Site, I agree to participate as a volunteer, without compensation or payment for my services.

Liability and Workers' Compensation Protections for Volunteers

Qualified volunteers receive the same liability protections and workers' compensation coverage as state employees when they are training for or responding to a public health event or in an emergency. To be qualified for these protections, volunteers must serve at the request of and under the direction and control of a state agency, such as the Department of Health, they may not receive hourly or salary compensation from a state agency and additional criteria also may apply. Vermont law also provides certain liability protections for qualified partnerships, associations and businesses engaged in emergency management activities. The full text of these laws includes additional information about eligibility and the extent of the coverage and is available online as indicated below.

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APPENDIX II: PRIVACY POLICY

Overview

The State of Vermont's Department of Health (VDH) is strongly committed to protecting the privacy of registrants of the Vermont Emergency Response Volunteers (VERV) VDH wants to contribute to providing a safe and secure environment for our VERV users. The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to inform you, as a user of the VERV Site, what kinds of information VERV will gather about you when you visit the Site.

Disclosure of Personal Information

When registering on the Site as a volunteer in the Vermont Emergency Response Volunteers registry, registrants agree to provide certain personal identifying information and professional credentialing information (collectively, Registration Information). VERV collects, uses, and maintains this Registration Information in implementing the Vermont Emergency Response Volunteers registry. VERV administrators do not use the Registration Information provided by volunteer registrants to the Site except to the extent described in the Site's Terms of Service.

Analytics Data

VERV and the Vermont Department of Health automatically gathers and stores certain information about website visits
